RE: 8WLC-TWG1516 – Tehery-Wager Geoscience Project – Request for renewal of Approval for the use of water or deposit of waste without a licence

The Geological Survey of Canada, in collaboration with partners from the Canada-Nunavut Geoscience Office and Canadian universities, is planning on conducting a second field season in the Tehery-Wager area in Nunavut this coming summer. The study area is located north of Chesterfield Inlet and east of Baker Lake and comprises all or parts of eight 1:250 000 scale NTS map sheets. Geological mapping and research will be conducted out of a temporary tent-based camp. The camp will consist of up to 16 people and have fuel stored on site for use with a helicopter, heating, and cooking.

With this letter and attached application, we would like to apply for the renewal of our approval for the use of water or deposit of waste without a licence and seek NWB's permission to proceed with our planned research during the summer of 2016.
