TITLE: Airborne Geophysics Survey

OBJECTIVES OF RESEARCH:

The Fury and Hecla Airborne Geophysical Survey will fill a gap in geophysical survey coverage on Baffin Island. The survey will be led by the Canada-Nunavut Geoscience Office (C-NGO), and its results will be directly applied to new regional geology mapping planned for 2018-2019. The survey is proposed as a 2-year plan to be contracted to a Canadian-based geophysical survey company. The work will be based from Igloolik, and use up to 3 small fixed-wing aircraft. The first part of the survey should start around August 1st and end October 31st, 2017. The second part of the survey will follow a similar timeline in 2018. The full survey will be completed by December 2018.
