
Dear Sir:

The above noted license expires on September 1, 2002. The information with this letter and the annual reports on drilling filed March 28, 2001 and March 6, 2002 should complete the documentation to close this license. Kennecott did not carry out any work on this property in 2002.

The camp (Bigfoot) has been taken over by Tahera Corporation and they have applied for a DIAND land use permit to cover the camp. Kennecott will no longer require a water license for this property.

Attached is a location map and a photo layout (looking west) of the camp. A list of the remaining structures and equipment is also attached. The area taken up by the camp buildings and equipment is approximately 30metres x 30metres, and the western edge of the camp is a minimum of 100metres from high water mark of the lake. Water for the camp was drawn from this unnamed lake to the west of the camp using electric pump, hose and mesh filter. The outhouses with sewage and grey water sumps are located to the east of the camp, behind the office shack (between the helicopter and generator shacks).

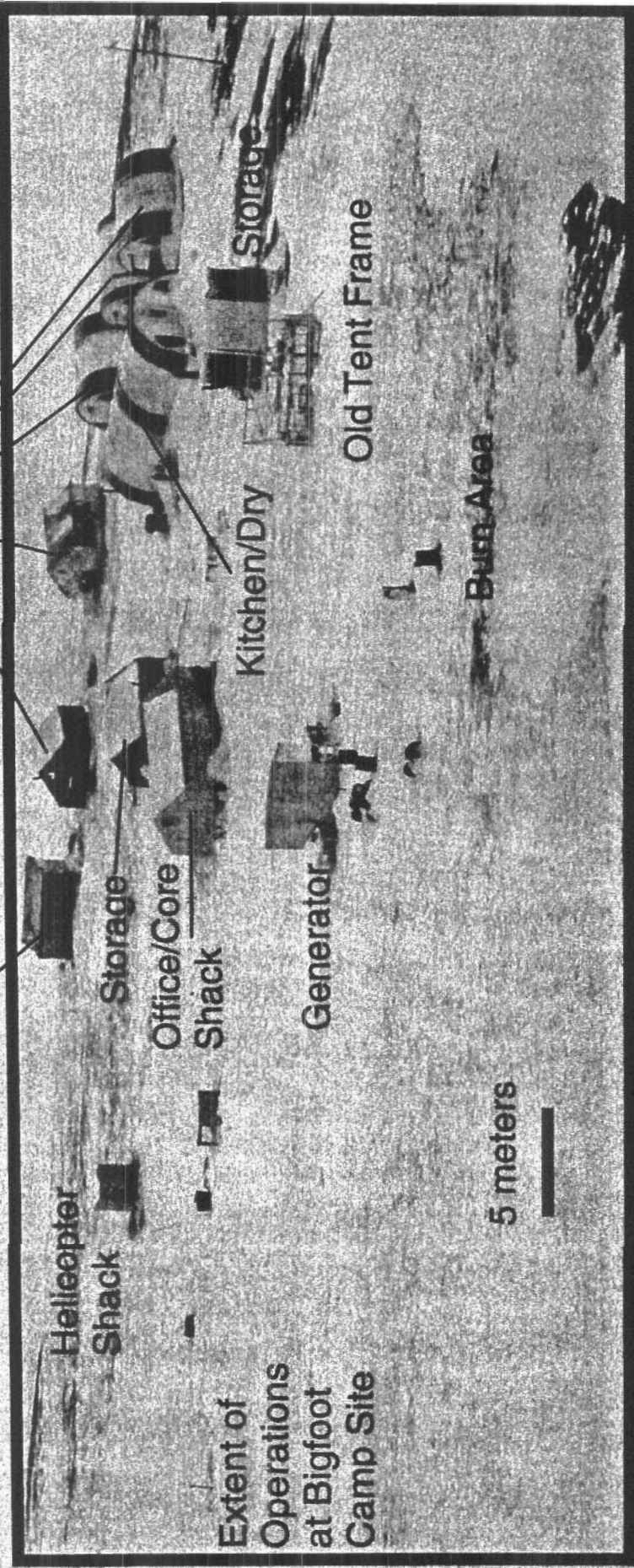
