I'm concerned about what type of contaminates will be getting into the water system that will be effecting the aquatic wildlife in that camp area and the disturbance from machinery at the site as it's very good lake for fishing.

During the spring that location is also a major caribou migration route and the least amount of disturbance during that time until after the migration and this also should be observed during the fall too so they don't alter the caribou migration routes.
