In response to the NIRB's November 15, 2017 correspondence, TMAC anticipates the submission date of the Madrid-Boston FEIS to be delivered to the NIRB's Cambridge Bay office on December 21st, 2017.

Annex V1-7 of the FEIS will include an application for Amendment No. 2 of Water Licence 2AM-DOH1323 and a application for a Type A Water Licence to support water use and waste management associated with the Boston Site.
