




 The mandate of the Fisheries Protection Program is to maintain the sustainability and ongoing productivity of commercial, recreational and Aboriginal fisheries.

Fisheries Protection Program - Legislation Fisheries Act Section 35 Prohibits serious harm to fish Allows for authorization of impacts with conditions Sections 20, 21 Requirement for sufficient water, fish passage Species at Risk Act Sections 32, 33, 58 Prohibits killing, harming, harassing, capturing or taking of listed species, destruction of residence, critical habitat Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (Article 12)
