SECTION 1	Comments	Non-Compliance with Act or Licence	Action Required
Background:			

On March 22,2023, I Jonathan Mesher of CIRNAC conducted inspections of Water Licence facilities under the licence 2AM-BRP1831 at Goose Camp. During this inspection I was accompanied by; Thomas Bolt and Merle Keefe (Sabina Employees)

a. Water Intake

I. Water records appear up to date and the water meter appeared to be operating as intended.

b. Waste Storage

- I. While inspecting the Temporary Waste Storage Facility There was multiple totes and drums of Hazardous Materials outside of containment. The BACK RIVER PROJECT Landfill and Waste Management Plan, section 6.4.2 states that; "Hazardous waste will be stored inside or within lined containment facilities at the Goose Property and MLA to minimize potential leaching to the environment." With the presence hazardous waste outside containment it appears the licensee is not adhering to the approved Landfill and waste management plan.
- II. The licensee has removed most of the historical waste pile and transported it off site, the remainder of the waste is stored near the runway to be flown off site. During the inspection there was multiple barrels of the historical waste pushed into a snow pile.
- III. During the inspection there was 58 totes of CAT transmission fluid outside of containment, this hazardous material was stored behind the bulk fuel storage.
- IV. No concerns were noted regarding the bull fuel storage berms while on site.
- V. The fuel tank for the portal shop was not placed in secondary containment.
- VI. While on site the inspector noted 2 pallets of used batteries outside of containment, multiple batteries were not stored upright.

Section 2

Non-Compliance with Act or Licence

Action Required

The licensee is to provide a plan 3 weeks after receiving the report to ensure the following concerns are addressed, this plan shall include a timeline for implementation.

- 1) The licensee is to remove the barrels of historical waste from the snow pile near the runway.
- 2) During the last 3 inspections the inspector has noted improper storage of hazardous materials and hazardous wastes in the temporary waste storage facility and throughout the site, it appears the licensee has a capacity issue and is unable to handle their waste in accordance with the terms and conditions of the licence 2AM-BRP, the licensee must? provide a plan to ensure all Hazardous materials are properly contained in accordance with the licence and management plans. Due to the frequency of this issue the inspector may proceed with enforcement actions if this issue is present in the upcoming inspections.
- 3) The licensee is to ensure all hazardous waste and hazardous materials is stored in a way to prevent waste from entering water and is consistent with the approved licence/Management plans.
