<p>Background:</p> <p>On March 22,2023, I Jonathan Mesher of CIRNAC conducted inspections of Water Licence facilities under the licence 2AM-BRP1831 at MLA Camp. During this inspection I was accompanied by; Christian Standring (B2Gold Employee)</p> <p>Due to technical issues this report is issued without photos.</p> <p>a. Water Intake</p> <p>1. This camp obtains its fresh water from the ocean using a desalination unit located on a laydown area adjacent to Bathurst inlet.</p> <p>b. Waste Storage</p> <p>1. In the Previous inspection (March 22, 2023) it was noted that multiple fuel tanks for the diesel heaters were outside of containment, The licensee has since installed secondary containment for these mentioned fuel tanks.</p> <p>2. During the inspection it was noted that the licensee has installed two waste containment facilities, one for hazardous waste and the second for a truck wash area, both containment areas are beneficial to the site for preventing waste from contaminating the environment. While reviewing the NWB website I was unable to locate the required plans and submissions for the construction of waste management structures.</p> <p>3. No concerns were noted regarding the construction of the bulk fuel containment area.</p> <p>4. The site was clean and well kept at the time of the inspection.</p>
