However, it is the department's expectation that, if B2Gold is considering alternative dewatering strategies, such as the passive overflow of water from Umwelt Lake, then an updated version of the Llama and Umwelt Lake Dewatering Plan is warranted to reflect these changes, including the identification of potential impacts and mitigation measures associated with any alternative.
