On May 20, 2014 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) received TMAC Resources Inc.'s (TMAC) 2013 Annual Report for Doris North Gold Mine Project Certificate NIRB No. 003 (2013 Annual Report) as required by Appendix D of the Doris North Gold Mine Project Certificate [No. 003] issued by the NIRB in November 26, 2007.

As per Section 12.7 of the Nunavut Land Claim Agreement (NLCA) and provisions set out in the Doris North Project Certificate, the NIRB's monitoring program focuses on compliance and effects monitoring. The NIRB is therefore requesting that interested parties review the 2013 Annual Report and provide comments with respect to their jurisdiction and/or area of expertise by **June 27, 2014** on the following:

## 1) Compliance Monitoring

- Confirm compliance with, and provide information on, any instances of noncompliance, to all licences, permits, or authorizations that have been issued; and
- Confirmation as to whether any inspections were completed during the 2013 reporting period, and if so, provide a summary of the results of those inspections.

## 2) Effects Monitoring

- Comment on whether the conclusions reached by TMAC in its 2013 Annual Report are valid:
- Discuss any areas of significance requiring further studies, outlining what may be required; and

Suggest changes to the monitoring program which may be warranted.
