Re: Anticipated date for submission of information in support of TMAC's application for modifications to the Doris North Gold Mine Project

Dear John Roberts:

On December 9, 2013 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received an application from TMAC Resources Inc. (TMAC) for proposed modifications to the Doris North Gold Mine Project (the Project) and related amendments to the NIRB Project Certificate [No. 003].

As a part of the NIRB's reconsideration of the Doris North Project Certificate pursuant to section 12.8.2 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), it offered interested parties an opportunity to submit information requests (IRs), the responses to which would assist parties in developing their technical review comments. By March 10, 2014 the NIRB received information requests which were forwarded on to TMAC for response. On April 22, 2014 the NIRB received TMAC's response to all IRs received from parties. In addition, in the email accompanying the submission TMAC indicated that supplemental information to the response had been submitted via regular post, and the cover letter detailed that information regarding additional amendment activities would be submitted for consideration by the NIRB and the NWB "in the near future".

In correspondence issued April 30, 2014, the NIRB notified TMAC that it would not move forward with its technical review of the application to modify the Project and to amend the Project Certificate until information regarding all proposed modifications was provided to the Board. To date, the NIRB has not received any additional information in support of TMAC's proposed Project modifications.

The NIRB respectfully requests that TMAC provide an update with respect to its anticipated date of submission of further information in support of its amendment application, and would ask that this be provided to our office via email at info@nirb.ca by **December 19, 2014**.
