RE: Format of Final Hearing

Dear Parties,

The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) would like to provide an update regarding the format of the Final Hearing for the Doris North Project which will take place from January 30 to February 3, 2006, in Cambridge Bay.

In its Preliminary Hearing Conference Decision of September 13, 2005, the Board indicated that the Final Hearing would be conducted by subject rather than by intervenor. However, in retrospect NIRB realizes that conducting the Final Hearing in this manner will result in far too many presentations for the technical time period. In light of this, NIRB has decided that the Final Hearing will be conducted by intervenor and that the presentations should be formatted according to the information and key areas as follows:

- 1. Intervenor mandate and relevant legislation, policies, guidelines, etc.;
- 2. The assessment of alternatives to the use of Tail Lake for tailings disposal;
- 3. The Tail Lake water quality and water management plan;
- 4. The design of the jetty and related issues including effects on fish habitat, shoreline erosion, and the sea bed:
- 5. The wildlife monitoring and mitigation plan including cumulative effects assessment;
- 6. The socio-economic impact of the project on affected residents and communities of Nunavut; and
- 7. Other issues.

The proponent, Miramar Hope Bay Limited, will be allowed to present its project in detail prior to the presentations by intervenors. A draft agenda is attached.
