- 1. The wildlife mitigation and monitoring plan including cumulative effects assessment;
- 2. The Tail Lake water quality and water management strategy;
- 3. The assessment of alternatives to the use of Tail Lake for tailings disposal;
- 4. The design of the jetty and related issues including effects on fish habitat, shoreline erosion and the seabed; and
- 5. The socio-economic impact of the project on affected residents and communities of Nunavut.
