HBML submitted the attached document to the NWB last week in response to parties concerns regarding their application for amendment #3 to WL 2AM-DOH0713 (including request for approval of Waste Rock and Ore Management Plan). Before bringing this file to the Board there are a few outstanding issues raised by EC that should be resolved including the following:

- (1) the geochemical sampling frequency for confirmatory testing of waste rock (diabase);
- (2) The interpretation of Mine Environment Neutral Drainage Prediction Manual (Price, 2009); and
