RE: Doris North Gold Mine Project – Comment Regarding TMAC's Application to Amend Type A Water Licence 2AM-DOH1323

Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) has reviewed the information submitted to the Nunavut Water Board regarding the above-mentioned amendment application and is submitting an additional comment. ECCC's specialist advice is provided based on our mandate, in the context of the Canadian Environmental Protection Act and the pollution prevention provisions of the Fisheries Act. The Proponent must ensure that they remain in compliance with legislation during all phases and in all undertakings related to the project.

The amended Doris North project will involve the management of significant volumes of saline minewater which TMAC proposes to discharge into the marine receiving environment. Pursuant to the Metal Mining Effluent Regulations (MMER) all such effluent must be demonstrated to be non-acutely toxic using bioassay testing. Additional information is in the attached ECCC letter to TMAC dated December 23, 2015.

ECCC requests that TMAC develop alternative minewater management strategies, and suggest that this be done in advance of the upcoming technical sessions.
