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NWB Background Info

NWB-kut Unniqtutai Tuhaghitit

- Institution of Public Government (IPG) established under Article 13 of the *Nunavut Land Claims Agreement* (NLCA)
- Kavamagiyauqatauyut Inungnut (IPG-kut) pinguaqtauyut malikhugit Nakataani 13 tapkunani *Nunavutagutitut Angigutit* (NLCA)
- Responsibilities and powers over the regulation, use, and management of freshwater in the Nunavut Settlement Area...
- Havalgit Hakugiknilgitlu maligainut, atuqni, aulataunilu imigaulat imait Nunavutagauyup Iluani ...



NWB Background Info (Cont.)

➤ Objects of the NWB are to:

Provide for the conservation and utilization of waters in Nunavut, except in national parks, in a manner that provides optimum benefit for the residents of Nunavut in particular and Canadians in general.

Sec.35 Nunavut Waters And Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act

- Based on its mandate, the NWB may issue any of the following authorizations to regulate the use of water and/or the deposit of waste for activities or undertakings occurring within Nunavut Settlement Area:
 - Approval Without a Licence

Licences Issued to the Project

Laisauyut Tuniyauyut Havanguyumun

2AM-DOH0713

- Issued by the NWB on September 19, 2007 expired on September 30, 2013
- Authorized use of water of 480,000 cm/year and the deposit of Waste in support of a Mining and Milling undertaking
- Three approved Amendments:
 - No. 1 relocation of the Explosives Mixing and Storage Facility
 - No. 2 infrastructure expansion, set new monitoring stations
 - No.3 conditions applying to waste rock management

2AM-DOH0713

Licences Issued to the Project (Cont.)

Laisauyut Tuniyauyut Havanguyumun (Huli)

2AM-DOH1323

- Issued by the NWB on August 16, 2013 will expiry on August 15, 2023
- Authorizes the use of 480,000 cm of Water/year and Waste disposal
- A mining rate of 720 tonnes per day of ore
- The subaqueous deposition of tailings into the Tail Lake (TIA as per Schedule 2 of MMER)
- The controlled discharge of effluent to Doris Creek from the TIA Security furnished \$13.090 million

2AM-DOH1323

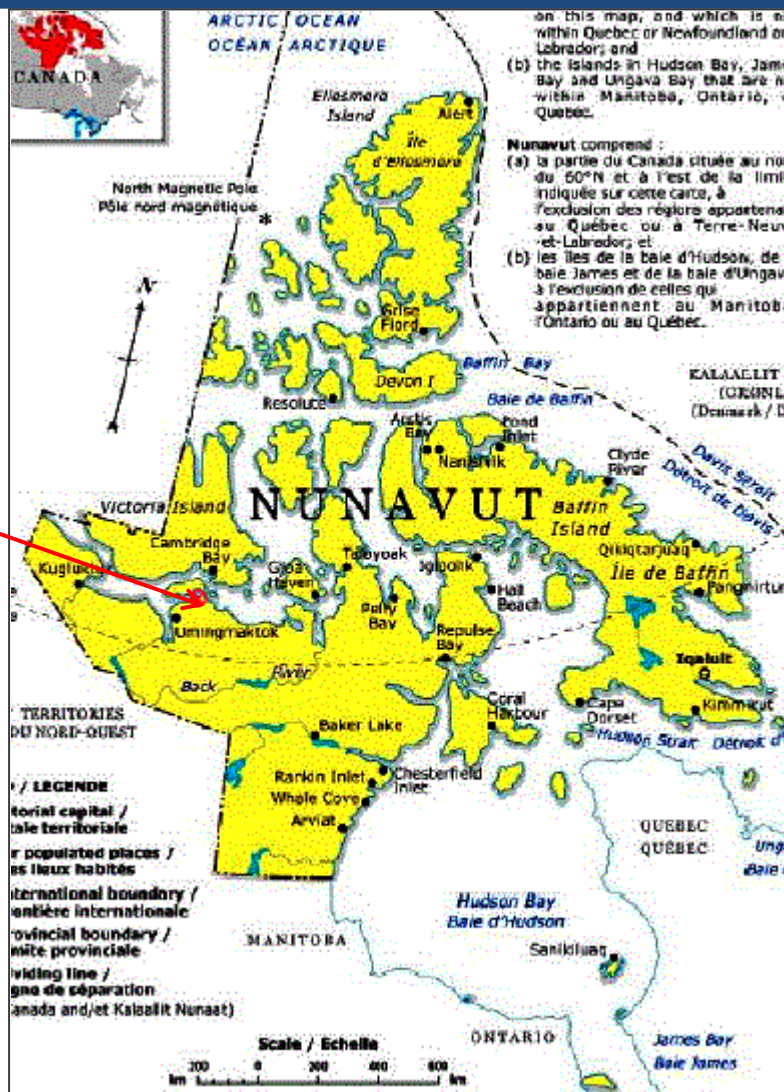

Project Overview

Havanguyuq Tamaat Takunia

Location:

- DNP is located on IOL in the Kitikmeot region South of Robert's Bay ~ 125 km SW of Cambridge Bay

General Description :

- Underground gold mine
- LOM 2 years
- Water sources: Doris & Windy Lakes
- Cyanide leaching process
- Gold Dore bars final product

Inigiya:

Project Overview (Cont.)

Havanguyuq Tamaat Takunia (huli)

Current status of the Project:

- The Project was under C&M (temporary closure) from Jan 2009 until Summer 2015
- On April 2015 TMAC provided the Boards with notification of its intention to re-start construction activities at site
- Construction re-started in summer 2015
- Operations to start in Jan 2017

Application Scope – General Tukhigaut Havangi - Tamitnut

Proposed Changes: General

- LOM 6 years
- Initial mining and milling rate of 1,000 tpd up to 2,000 tpd
- Camp expansion (up to 280 personnel)
- Expanded laydown areas at Roberts Bay to better support sealift
- New landfill location (in a quarry site) for operational and closure waste

Uuktutit Ahianguqnit: Tamaitnut

- LOM 6 ukiunut
- Hivulliq uyagakhiurniq Havikhaliurniqlu aktilanga 1,000 tpd tikitlugu 2,000 tpd
- Hiniktaqvik attaqtuhigiaqnia (tikitlugu 280 havaktinut)
- Attaqtuhivalliqnia iliuqaqvik nuna talvani Roberts Bay nakuutqiyamik ikayuqtugianga umiakkuqnit
- Nutaq nunami iqaqvik inikha (iluani tuapaktaqviuyup) aulatyutikhainut hiamalaittumiklu iqakuqvik



Application Scope: Tailings

Tukhigaut Havakhai: Uyagaktaqviup Kuvittaqvia

Proposed Changes: Tailings Managment

- Subaerial tailings deposition
- Process gravity tailings (94%) to TIA
- Treated cyanide tailings (6%) underground
- South Dam design to include a frozen foundation
- New tailings retention structure:
 - Interim Dike constructed accross the midpoint of TIA

Uuktutit Ahianguqnit: Uyagaktaqnikut Kuvittaqvia Aulania

- Hilainaqhiqtut uyagaktaqnikut kuvittaqvi
- Havaknit kivittaqtut uyagaktaqnikut kuvittaqnit (94%) Kuvittaqvikmun
- Halumaqhaqhimayut cyanide kuvittaqnit (6%) nunap iluani
- Nigiani Haput hanatyuhikha ilalik qiqumayumik tunngavikha
- Nutaq kuvittaqvik huniumaitnia hanatyuhia :
 - Atulaktuq Haputa hanania ikaqhugu qitiqpaani Kuvittaqviup



Application Scope: Water Management

Tukhigaut Havakhai: Imaq Aulataunia

Proposed Changes: Water Management

- Additional PCP
- Excess reclaim water
(up to 4,000 cum/day in summer) is treated for TSS, mixes with the saline groundwater and discharges to Roberts Bay (up to 7,000 m³/day summer)

Uuktutit Ahianguqnit: Imaq Aulataunia

- Ilagiaqnii PCP-ngi
- Avatqumani utiqtitauunit immait
(tikitlugu 4,000 cum/ubluqmun auyami) halumaqtiqhimayut Katitlugit Puktalaqtut Naptunit, akutni tagiuvaluknut maniqami imaqtainut kuviyauyutlu talvunga Roberts Bay (tikitlugu 7,000 m³/ubluqmun auyami)



Application Scope: Water Management (Cont.) Tukhigaut Havakhai: Imaq Aulataunia (Huli)

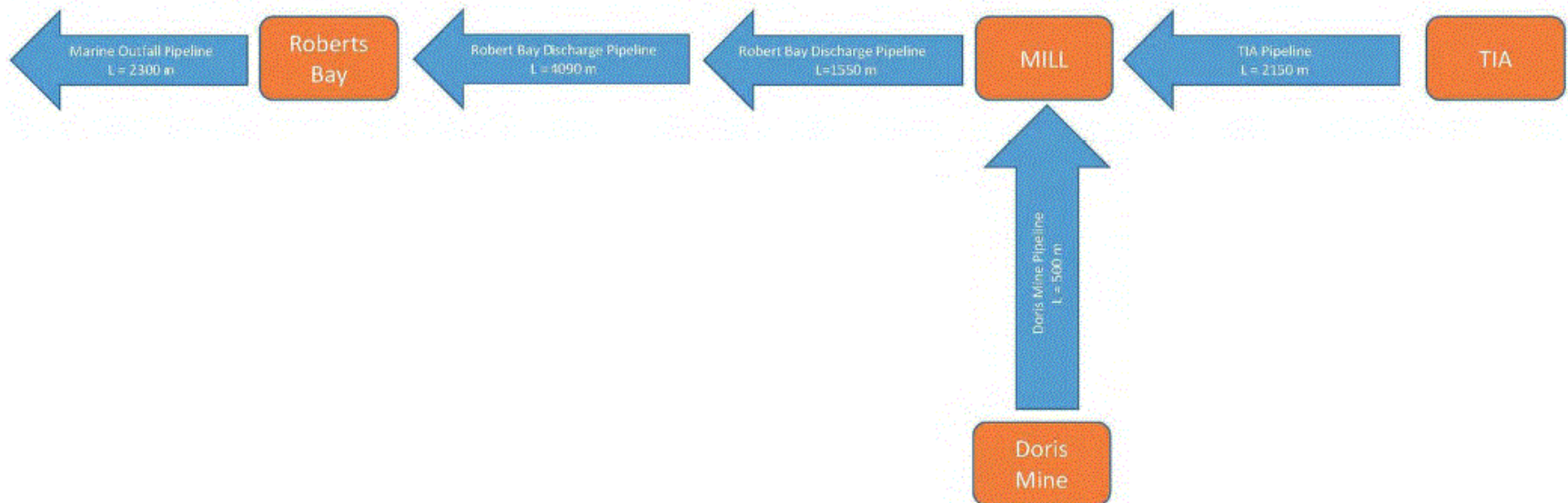
- Groundwater: discharge directly to Roberts Bay from mine (up to 3,000 cm per day, year round)
- Effluent:
 - MMER-compliant at end of pipe
 - CCME PAL (marine)-compliant at the end of the mixing zone
 - No onsite laboratory
- Maniqami Imaq: kuvigaqni tugaqpiaqhugu Roberts Bay uyagakhiurvikmin tikitlugu 3,000 cm ubluqmun, ukiunga tamaat)
- Imaqta Halumaittuqt:
 - MMER-nut malikhaqni ihuani huplup
 - CCME PAL-ngi (tagiumi)-malikhaqni ihuani akuttiviup
 - Piittuq havakvikmi naunaiyaivikmik

Tukhigaut Havakhai: Imaq Aulataunia (Huli)

Application Scope: C&R

Tukhigaut Havakhai: Umiknia Halumaqtinqnialu

Proposed changes: Closure & Reclamation Plan

- Tailings: 0.3 m rock cover and breaching of the North Dam
- TIA effluent: once compliant, discharge to Doris Creek (post-closure)
- All Waste Rock disposed of underground, none on surface
- Closure cost estimate: \$25M

Uuktutit Ahianguqnit: Umiknia Halummaqtinqnialu Upalungaiyaut

- Kuvittaqvit: 0.3 miitat uyaqat haunia nakataunialu tamna Ungalaani Haput
- Kuvittaqviup Imaqta Halumaittuq: malikhaliqat, kuvipkaqlugu talvunga Doris Kuugauyaq (umiqaqtitlugu)
- Tamaita Iqakut Uyagait iliuqaqnit nunap iluanut, piqalaittuq nunap qangani
- Umiknianut akitunia mikhautnia : \$25M



Application Procedural History Tukhigaut Pitquhit Atuqhimani

Current Status of the Application

- On June 15, 2015 the NWB received TMAC's application for amendment of Water Licence 2AM-DOH1323
- On June 23, 2015 the NIRB received a submission from TMAC which requested a reconsideration of the terms and conditions of the Doris Project Certificate No.003
- TMAC stated its desire for the NIRB's reconsideration process and the NWB's licensing process to proceed as a NIRB/NWB coordinated process

Application Procedural History (Cont.) Tukhigaut Pitquhit Atuqhimani (Huli)

- On November 4, 2015 the NIRB and the NWB jointly provided notice that TMAC submissions to both Boards had complied with the NIRB and the NWB requirements
- As a result, the NIRB and the NWB commenced a coordinated public technical review period
- Details of the submissions received for the application were provided during the technical meeting today

Next Steps – NWB Process

Tukliit Atuqtakhat – NWB-kut Pityuhi

- With respect to the NIRB and NWB coordinated technical review approach, until the NIRB reconsideration process is complete the NWB will not proceed beyond this technical review stage of the Application
- The NWB will await the completion of the NIRB consideration of the Project Certificate Amendments before proceeding to the next step in the NWB's processing of the Application: the scheduling of the Pre – Hearing Conference

Next Steps – NWB Process (Cont.)

Tukliit Atuqtakhat – NWB-kut Pityuhi (Huli)

- Should the NIRB and/or the Minister conclude that the Project Certificate not be amended, the amendment process for the Water Licence would be suspended and would not proceed to the next stage
- Pikpata tapkuat NIRB-kut naunaiqhini tamna Havanguyuq Titigartaq ihuaqhigiangitpat, tamna ihuaqhigiagut pityuhiq Imaqmun Laisaliqutit nuqagatlakniaq kayuhilaittuqlu tuklikhainut atuqtakhat
