ECCEC's Role in Nunavut

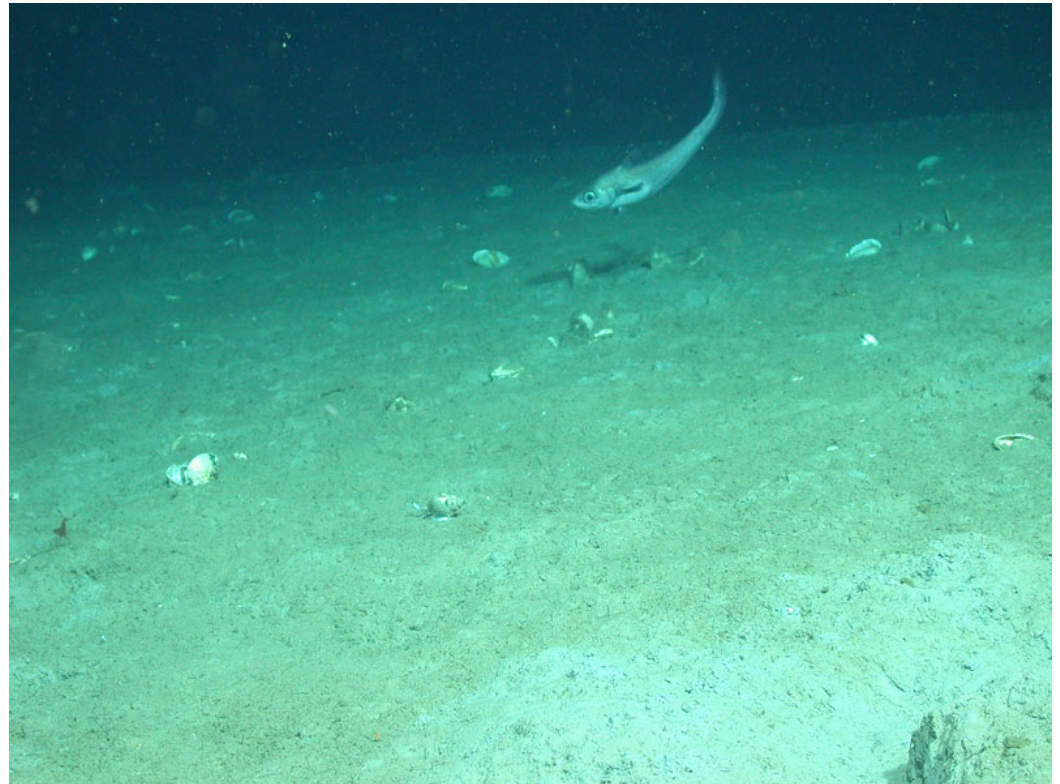
- Review development and remediation proposals for environmental impacts falling within ECCEC's mandate.
