Application of the Type "A" Water Licence, Doris North Project: Close of the

Public Hearing Record

Further to the Nunavut Water Board's (NWB or Board) letter of June 24, 2013 regarding the Pre-Hearing Conference Decision (PHC Decision) for the Application to amend and renew Water Licence 2AM-DOH0713, outlining the procedural requirements and timetable for the written hearing, the Board received, final submissions from the Kitikmeot Inuit Association and Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC). Follow-up correspondence regarding a final response was received from TMAC Resources Inc. on July 8, 2013. No further or additional submissions were received by the deadlines indicated in the PHC Decision.

The Board wishes to advise all interested parties that the Public Hearing record for the Nunavut Water Board's Public Hearing regarding TMAC Resources Inc.'s Type "A" Water Licence 2AM-DOH0713 Application for the Doris North Project is now **CLOSED**. Accordingly, no additional evidence in respect of the Application may be filed with the Board and the Hearing Record will consist of the documentation filed in advance of the Hearing, the written evidence filed during the Hearing and the written confirmations filed with the Board.

Now that the Hearing Record is closed, the Application will be remitted to the Panel who will, in due course¹, issue a decision report to the Minister of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada regarding whether or not to issue a renewed (with amendments) Type A Licence to TMAC Resources Inc. If the Board's decision is to recommend that a Type A Licence be issued, the Board will also attach a copy of the licence to the decision report for the review of the Minister.

As indicated above, the Public Hearing Record is now closed and the Panel in deliberations, therefore the Board will not provide any further comment regarding this Application until the Board publicly issues its decision regarding the Application.
