

Summary of Draft Doris-Madrid and Boston



Part B – General Conditions

- Type BB Licences should not be integrated into Type A Water Licences – exploration is distinct from exploration
- Requesting board approval of all plans required to proceed with construction and operation of the Project
- Requesting deemed approval of plans after 60 days

Part C – Security

- KIA/TMAC/CIRNAC have agreed on quantum, staging (tranches), split
- Changes to security amounts may be made on board approval-should not require amendment in every case
- Mechanism to allow board to reduce security due to Minister under Type A Water Licence where TMAC can show Minister already hold security for same facility under another instrument (ex – CIRNAC Land Lease, Type B)

Part D – Construction and Operation

- minor updates to reflect completed obligations

Part E – Use of Water

- Doris-Madrid - Requesting total 1,973,800 m3 plus annually variable amounts for winter road
- Boston - requesting total 483,000 m3 plus annually variable amounts for winter road
- Part F – Water Management
- minor updates to reflect completed obligations
- Mechanism to permit winter track/road water use

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Part G – Waste Management

- Discharge criteria for discharge to tundra from contact water ponds, sumps, fuel storage facilities, landfill and landfarm facilities
- Revision to required TIA water quality assessment
- Boston WTP

- Minor wording changes to specified reclamation requirements for clarity
- Requirement to update Interim Closure and Reclamation Plan with a Layout to illustrate how the tranche triggers will be monitored on land at the TIA and TMA
