The Board also provides the following procedural guidance for the <u>next steps</u> in the Board's consideration of the Board-initiated Amendment:

- The Board invites the Licensee and interested persons to submit any further submissions or presentation
 materials for the upcoming teleconference Technical Meeting (TM) to the Board no later than March 15,
 2024 (3:00 p.m., MST)
- The Board proposes that the Board staff will hold a Technical Meeting (TM) by teleconference sometime in the week of **April 8**, **2024** (tentatively proposed for <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>April 09</u>, <u>2024</u>).
- This Notice of the Board-initiated Amendment will also be forwarded to the council of each municipality in the area(s) most affected and Notice of the Amendment shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the area(s) affected or, if there is no such newspaper, in such other manner as the Board considers appropriate.
- In the week before the Technical Meeting, the NWB will issue correspondence that will confirm the date, format, Agenda and other relevant details for the TM.
