Re: Agnico Eagle's Operational Notice – Civil Works for Emulsion Plant Pad on Madrid to TIA Road

Dear Mr. Shaikh,

Agnico Eagle Mines Limited (Agnico Eagle) is writing to provide the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) with notification that it intends to begin civil works for the Emulsion Plant Pad that is located approximately 4 km southwest of the Tailings Impoundment Area (TIA) along the Madrid to TIA road (Figures 1 and 2). Development of an explosives facility is approved as per 2AM-DOH1335, Part A, Item 1:

The activities and facilities included under the scope of 2AM-DOH1335 including Amendment No. 1 are as follows: [...] The handling and storage of petroleum products and hazardous materials including explosives, cyanide and other reagents.

Currently, Agnico Eagle plans to construct the laydown pad for the Emulsion Plant. A 60-day notice will be submitted prior to construction of the emulsion plant itself. All activities fall under Commercial Lease KTCL313D001 with the Kitikmeot Inuit Association (KitlA).
