Hi Jonathan and Jeremy,

We are in the midst of freshet here at Doris Camp and have received the sample results for our tank farms (please see attached).

The Doris Tank Farm (ST-5), Robert's Bay Single 5ML Tank Farm (ST-6A) and Robert's Bay 3x5ML Tank Farm (ST-6B) have exceeded for TSS in samples that have been collected to date. All other parameters are below the discharge criteria.

In the past we have been permitted to use tank farm water for dust suppression on site roads if the TSS levels exceeded tundra discharge criteria as long as all other parameters are below the discharge criteria. This would not be used in areas near water crossings, and would like be used for the airstrip and roads around the main camp complex. I just wanted to confirm that we can continue with this practice this year.

We are hoping to start with this as soon as possible.

I can only seem to find the notification from 2015 in my files for this (attached). I can't seem to find the email correspondence with Eva in my archives. In the past we discharged water from the single 5ML tank farm either to the oversize pile located on the north side of the berm (which has a sediment control berm) or to the roads by truckload if there were slightly higher TSS.
