This letter is being submitted as notification of planned replacement of our existing Waste Water Treatment Plant and Burn Pan.

The Doris existing site Wastewater Treatment Plant has been in operation since 2009 and is in need of replacement due to routine wear and tear. TMAC will be installing a new plant, of the same make and model, to replace the old plant. Both the new and old plants are of modular design containerized in seacans. This allows easy connection of the new plant modules. The new plant will function and be operated in the same way as the old plant.

Similarly, the Doris burn pan is in need of replacement due to wear and tear over the past years of use. A new burn pan, of similar design, is being constructed at site and will replace the old one.

The replacement of these facilities are not in contravention of the licence or the Act and are consistent with the NIRB Project Certificate. The facilities will continue to be operated in compliance with the Water Licence.
