**Refer: Notification under 2AM-DOH0713 - Part H – Item 1 Temporary Modification of the Conditions Applying to Water Supply Facilities and Waste Treatment at the Doris North Accommodations and Mill Site**

Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) reviewed the notification to the Nunavut Water Board by Newmont-Hope Bay under 2AM-DOH0713 - Part H – Item 1 Temporary Modification of the Conditions Applying to Water Supply Facilities and Waste Treatment at the Doris North Accommodations and Mill Site, dated May 6, 2008.
