Thank you for your September 26, 2019 invitation for Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC) to comment on the above referenced Spill Contingency Plan by TMAC Resources Inc. (TMAC). CIRNAC examined the submission pursuant to CIRNAC's mandated responsibilities under the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act* and the *Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Act*. CIRNAC is satisfied with the proposed changes, though we offer the following comment.

#### **1. CIRNAC Contact Information for Spill Reporting**

The CIRNAC Inspector contact information within the Spill Contingency Plan is out of date, due to changes within the department, and can be removed from the plan. Further, CIRNAC no longer considers it necessary for TMAC to contact CIRNAC Field Operations for spills reported to the Government of Nunavut Spill Line, as the Manager of Field Operations is contacted directly by the NWT/NU Spill Line for all reported spills. The CIRNAC Field Operations Manager contact information can also be removed from future versions of this plan, and all reportable spills can be reported directly to the NWT/NU Spill Line.
