Following the discovery of the Lupin gold deposit, exploration in the region resulted in the discovery of gold at George Lake in 1985 and at Goose Lake in 1987. Exploration was focused at George Lake until 1993 resulting in the discovery of a number of gold deposits. Following this point exploration shifted to Goose Lake, with the discovery of a number of additional gold occurrences. Various operators held the properties over the years, including Homestake, Auraco, Kinross and Miramar Mining. Dundee Precious Metals became a 100% owner/operator of the project in 2006. Sabina acquired a 100% interest in the project in June, 2009.
