HP shall not be held liable by the Customer or by any third party for the failure of a NUANS Report or a NUANS Database Pre-Search to disclose any name with prior rights. HP expressly excludes all liability and damages resulting from the inaccuracy or incompleteness of, or omissions from, any NUANS Report.

EXTRA-PROVINCIAL CORPORATE PROCEDURES GUIDE

This guide will review a number of ongoing obligations and requirements imposed by the Business Corporations Act of Alberta (the "Act") upon an extra-provincial corporation registered in Alberta.

1. Use of Name

Section 287 states that:

287 An extra-provincial corporation shall set out its name in legible characters in or on all contracts, invoices, negotiable instruments, orders for goods or services issued or made by or on behalf of the extra-provincial corporation in the course of carrying on business in Alberta.

This is an identical obligation to that imposed on corporations registered and incorporated in Alberta. As the concept of limited liability is such an important shelter to individuals carrying on business, the Courts in Alberta and other provinces have interpreted these types of sections very strictly. FAILURE TO CLEARLY DISCLOSE THE CORPORATION'S NAME MAY RESULT IN PERSONAL LIABILITY TO THE AGENT WHO PURPORTS TO ACT ON ITS BEHALF.

If an extra-provincial corporation carries on business in Alberta under an approved pseudonym in accordance with section 283, the "name" referred to in section 287 must be the assumed name.

2. Annual Filings

Subsection 292(1) states that:

292(1) A registered extra-provincial corporation shall, in each year on or before the last day of the month immediately following its anniversary month, send to the Registrar a return in prescribed form and the Registrar shall file it.

The time for registration is the "anniversary month" which is defined by subsection 276(a) as the month in which the Certificate of Registration was issued in Alberta, and not the month of incorporation in the incorporating jurisdiction.

The information in the Return is required to ensure that there have been no material changes in the information filed previously with the Registrar's office.

The form is identical to the annual filing form for corporations registered in this Province. Accordingly, a corporation is required to list the following information when submitting the annual return:

- (a) Information about whether there has been a change of directors and if so, whether the necessary documentation has been filed with the Registrar;
- (b) The name and address of the shareholders, and the percentage of issued voting shares. If the corporation has more than five shareholders, it is necessary to list only the five with the greatest percentage of issued voting shares. If the corporation is public, or distributing, or unable to provide the required information, the name and the complete mailing address of the transfer agent is to be included;
- (c) Change of Attorney or Alternate Attorney (Form 27 or 27.1) must be completed and attached to the annual return if not already filed; and
- (d) If the extra-provincial corporation is a public corporation, financial information may also have to be submitted as required under the Act.

In addition to the information provided in the annual filing, the Registrar, pursuant to subsection 279(2), may require such further or other information as he may reasonably determine.

3. Changes to Charter Documents or Name

Section 289(1) states:

- 289(1) A registered extra-provincial corporation shall send to the Registrar:
 - (a) a copy of each amendment to its charter within one month after the effective date of the amendment, verified in a manner satisfactory to the Registrar.

In accordance with the requirements of this section, any changes or amendments to the charter of the extra-provincial corporation must be filed with the Registrar within one month after the effective date of the amendment. These charter amendments would, of course, originate in the incorporating jurisdiction.

A corporation's charter is defined in subsection 276(c) to include:

- (a) A statute, ordinance or other law incorporating an extra-provincial corporation as amended from time to time;
- (b) Letters patent of incorporation and any letters patent supplementary to them;
- (c) A memorandum of association, as amended from time to time;
- (d) Any other instrument of incorporation, as amended from time to time; and
- (e) Any certificate, licence or other instrument evidencing incorporation.

The Registrar will accept certified or notarially certified copies of amended charter documents.

If the amendment effects a change in the name under which the extra-provincial corporation is registered, the Registrar, pursuant to subsection 289(4), is required to issue a new certificate of amendment of registration in prescribed form and change his records accordingly. A further computerized name search will also be required.

4. Change to Address of Head Office or Membership on the Board

Subsection 289(1)(c) states that:

289(1) A registered extra-provincial corporation shall send to the Registrar

- (c) a notice in prescribed form of any change in:
 - (i) the address of its head office in or outside Alberta, or
 - (ii) the membership of its board of directors, board of management or other governing body.

The notice to be submitted for changes in the composition of the board is Form 6. It is the same form that is used for Alberta corporations. Subsection 289(2) requires the address and occupation of each new board member. The notice must be filed within one month after the effective date of the change.

Form 28 is required to be submitted to the Registrar in the event of a change of head office of an extra-provincial corporation. The new address and the effective date of change are the operative requirements. The notice must also be filed within one month after the effective date of the change.

5. Changing Attorneys

The extra-provincial corporation is entitled at any time to send to the Registrar a notice in prescribed form of any change in its Attorney or Alternate Attorney (subsection 288(5)), and the Registrar is required to file that notice. Every extra-provincial corporation registered in Alberta is obligated to appoint an attorney. By his appointment, that attorney is both authorized and obligated to receive service of documents required or permitted by law to be sent to the extra-provincial corporation. Changes relating to the registered attorney must be filed forthwith.

An attorney for an extra-provincial corporation need not be a lawyer; the attorney referred to in subsection 288 is merely an agent.

In addition to accepting service of legal documents, the attorney is obligated to keep his address current in the Registrar's records, and to provide both his principal and the Registrar not less than sixty days' notice of his intention to resign. The office of the attorney must also be accessible during normal business hours, and readily identifiable from the information set out in the prescribed form (Form 27).

The extra-provincial corporation must exercise a high degree of care in its choice of attorney for the failure of that individual to properly execute his function could have a serious impact on the corporation. A failure to promptly respond to a statement of claim or a garnishee could prove to be a needless expense.

6. Amalgamation

If an extra-provincial corporation is involved in an amalgamation with one or more extra-provincial corporations, subsection 290(1) requires the following documents to be filed with the Registrar within one month after the effective date of the amalgamation:

- (a) A copy of any instrument effecting an amalgamation of the extra-provincial corporation with one or more other extra-provincial corporations,
- (b) A copy of the amalgamation agreement, if any; and
- (c) A statement in prescribed form relating to the amalgamated extra-provincial corporation and the documents referred to in section 280(2).

An extra-provincial corporation may be authorized under subsection 180.1(1) to amalgamate with an Alberta corporation:

7. Cancellation, Suspension, Revocation and Revival of an Extra-Provincial Corporation

(a) Cancellation by the Corporation

An extra-provincial corporation may effectively cease its ongoing registration obligations in Alberta by either ceasing to carry on business in Alberta, or by entering into voluntary liquidation.

Subsection 285(4) provides that:

285(4) An extra-provincial corporation that ceases to carry on business in Alberta shall send a notice to that effect to the Registrar.

There is no prescribed form in the regulations for the required notice and, in all likelihood, a letter to that effect will probably be satisfactory. Once such a notice is given, however, the Registrar may cancel the registration of the extra-provincial corporation on the assumption that he has reasonable grounds to believe that the extra-provincial corporation has indeed ceased carrying on business (subsection 285(1)(b)). In order to do so, however, the Registrar must comply with the provisions of subsection 285(2) discussed below.

If an extra-provincial corporation commences voluntary liquidation proceedings or is involved in an involuntary wind-up, the corporation or the liquidator is required to forthwith supply to the Registrar in Alberta:

- (i) a notice showing that the wind-up or liquidation proceedings have commenced (subsection 291(1)(a)),
- (ii) the address of the liquidator (subsection 291(1)(a)) and any changes to the liquidator (subsection 291(3)), and
- (iii) after completion of the proceedings, a return relating to the liquidation (subsection 291(1)(b)).

(b) Cancellation by the Registrar

Section 285 sets out several instances where the Registrar is granted the discretionary authority to cancel the registration of an extra-provincial corporation as follows:

(i) the extra-provincial corporation is in default for a period of one year in sending to the Registrar any fee, notice or document required by the Act,

- (ii) the extra-provincial corporation has sent a notice to the Registrar, or the Registrar has reasonable grounds to believe that the extra-provincial corporation has ceased to carry on business in Alberta,
- (iii) the extra-provincial corporation is dissolved,
- (iv) the extra-provincial corporation does not comply with a direction of the Registrar under subsection 282(2), or
- (v) the extra-provincial corporation has otherwise contravened the Act.

There must be a demonstrable failure to comply before the Registrar can cancel or revoke a Certificate. Subsection 285(2) requires the Registrar to follow a procedure designed to accord the extra-provincial corporation sufficient notice and opportunity to correct any deficiency. Subsection 285(2) provides that:

285(2) The Registrar shall not cancel the registration of an extra-provincial corporation under subsection (1) until

- (a) he has given at least 120 days' notice of the proposed cancellation with his reasons for it,
 - (i) to the extra-provincial corporation by registered mail addressed to its head office, and
 - (ii) to its attorney for service in accordance with section 288,
- (b) he has published a notice of the proposed cancellation in the Registrar's periodical, and
- (c) either no appeal is commenced under section 247 or, if an appeal has been commenced, it has been discontinued or the Registrar's decision is confirmed on the appeal.

(c) Effect of Revocation

Notwithstanding the fact that an extra-provincial corporation has been cancelled, subsection 286(2) expressly states that it remains fully liable for all obligations incurred before or after the cancellation or revocation of its extra-provincial registration in Alberta. The wording of that subsection is deliberately broad so as to provide protection for all third parties who may have had business dealings with the extra-provincial corporation.

Once the extra-provincial registration has been revoked, the corporation loses any rights that it otherwise has acquired by virtue of the fact of its registration.

(d) Reinstatement

An extra-provincial corporation may be reinstated to legally carry on business in Alberta simply by complying with section 285(3) which provides that:

285(3) The Registrar may reinstate the registration of an extra-provincial corporation that was cancelled under subsection (1)(a) on the receipt by the Registrar of its fees, notices and documents required to be sent to him and of the prescribed reinstatement fee.

The reinstatement process will basically be a repeat of the original registration procedure. A name approval will again be required.

8. Penalties

Section 296 contains a general penalty section for a breach of any of the provisions relating to extra-provincial corporations:

296 A person who contravenes this Part is guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000.

Note that the definition of "person" includes individuals as well as the corporation itself. It is also possible that the penalty could be imposed upon individual directors, officers or attorneys of the extra-provincial corporation.

9. Workers' Compensation

In the event an extra-provincial corporation engages in a business which falls within the definition of an "industry" under the Alberta Workers' Compensation Act, then compliance with that legislation will be required. A questionnaire will be forwarded from the Workers' Compensation Board which should be completed and returned directly to the Board.

10. Alberta Corporate Income Tax

Any corporation which has a "permanent establishment" in Alberta at any time in a taxation year must pay income tax as required by the Alberta Corporation Income Tax Act on its taxable income in Alberta. The corporation's accountant should be made aware of this requirement.

11. Business Licences & Taxes

Certain activities may not be undertaken in the Province until an appropriate permit, licence, or registration has been obtained. You should contact "Licencing of Trades & Businesses", 9945 - 50 Street, Edmonton, Alberta, telephone (780) 422-2590.

As well, most municipalities have licencing and zoning restrictions on the type of business you may carry on and the location of such business. You should contact local governing officials in that regard. For the City of Edmonton you should contact:

- (a) Licencing: Bylaw Enforcement, 2nd Floor, Chancery Hall, Edmonton, Alberta, telephone (780) 496-5233; and
- (b) Zoning: Zoning Department, 2nd Floor, Revillon Building, Edmonton, Alberta, telephone (780) 496-6194.

Most municipalities including the City of Edmonton assess a business tax on every business which tax is based primarily on the amount of leased space utilized.
