I'll have to check back through our files on this, but my understanding is that we are currently still awaiting a formal response from Shear regarding their plans for bringing the project into compliance with the NIRB PC. They did deliver hardcopies of all their NWB licence application materials to us at the NMS, however we do not have digital copies and would not be placing them on the NIRB ftp site regardless unless they were meant to form part of their compliance with the NIRB PC. We have their request for a name change to the NIRB PC and are ready to act on that and report back to the NWB once we have firm plans for NIRB PC compliance as well.
