Re: NIRB requesting information from authorizing agencies regarding Tahera's Environmental and Socio-Economic Report 2005

Dear Parties:

As you are aware, on May 31st, 2006 the Nunavut Impact Review Board ("NIRB") requested that interested parties review Tahera Diamond Corporation's *Environmental and Socio-Economic Report 2005* and provide comments by Friday, July 28th.

NIRB's monitoring program focuses on compliance and effects monitoring. To complete my report for the Board, at this time I am requesting information from authorizing agencies in regard to compliance monitoring, specifically:

- 1) How has each authorizing agency associated with the Jericho Project incorporated NIRB's Project Certificate terms and conditions into their respective licenses, authorizations or permits?
- 2) Have any inspections been conducted? If so, please provide me with copies.
- 3) Is Tahera in compliance with any licenses, authorizations or permits that have been issued? If not, what action has been taken?

With respect to effects monitoring, I am requesting any information regarding the following:

- 1) Are the conclusions reached by Tahera in its Report valid? If not, why?
- 2) Are there areas of significance requiring further study, and are changes to the monitoring program required?

Please feel free to include any other comments related to Tahera's environmental performance.
