RE: Assignment of Tahera Diamonds Water Licence to Shear Diamonds (Nunavut) Corp.

On August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2010 as part of the general sale of Tahera's assets at the Jericho site to Shear Minerals Ltd. and Shear Diamonds (Nunavut) Corp. the Kitikmeot Inuit Association (KIA) and the captioned companies (the companies) entered into an agreement which resulted in the assignment of the Water Compensation Agreement entered into between Tahera and KIA to the companies.
