KIA has received and reviewed the submission from Benachee Resources Inc. (“BRI”) titled *Aquatic Effects Monitoring Plan* for the Jericho Diamond Mine.

KIA appreciates the straightforwardness of the identification system for water sampling stations proposed in this plan. However, we recommend that the prefix for sampling stations being used to assess sediment chemistry be something other than WQ (e.g. replace the WQ prefix with SC). This would differentiate between those stations which are being used for water chemistry monitoring and those being used for sediment chemistry evaluation purposes.
