RE: Security for Type "A" Water Licence 2AM-JER1119

Ms. Lassonde:

The renewed Type "A" water licence 2AM-JER1119 specifies that Shear Diamonds (Nunavut) Inc. (Shear) must provide \$3,389,074 in security, of which \$2,200,000 is currently held by the Crown in the form of letters of credit. In order for your licence to be in compliance, Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) requires an additional \$1,189,074 to be submitted by July 31, 2012. Please be advised that, consistent with the plan submitted by Shear on March 6, 2012, AANDC will accept the transfer of \$868,000 security in cash or equivalents held pursuant to the expired Type "B" water licence NWB1JER0306 to the Type "A" water licence 2AM-JER1119 as well as the issuance of a secured promissory note for the remaining \$321,074 under the conditions set out below.

AANDC requires that Shear cause the amendment of the existing Letters of Credit issued by TD Commercial Bank, being Letters of Credit numbers 1992-9283587-05 for \$100,000, 1992-9283587-06 for \$100,000, 1992-9283587-03 for \$100,000, 1992-9283587-02 for \$100,000, 1992-9283587-04 for \$200,000, and 1992-9283587-01 for \$200,000, to reflect that they are now being held in relation to the obligations of Shear under the Type "A" water licence 2AM-JER1119, and not pursuant to licence NWB1JER0306. As well, AANDC requires that the amended Letters of Credit reflect the language set out in the attached template. After receiving the amended letters of credit, AANDC will return the original letters of credit held for NWB1JER0306. AANDC will also make a journal entry to confirm that the cash sum of \$68,000 being held by AANDC as security under the expired Type "B" water licence NWB1JER0306 shall be transferred as partial security for Shear's obligations under the Type "A" water licence 2AM-JER1119.

The secured promissory note for \$321,074 must be in a form and content acceptable to AANDC and must commit to a reimbursement schedule of equal payments synchronized with the diamond valuation schedule commencing August 29, 2012. The final payment must be made before resumption of commercial mining production at the Jericho mine (i.e., before processing of new feed other than the coarse reject pile) and, in any case, no later than July 31, 2013.



Please be advised that the acceptance of promissory notes is considered by AANDC on a case-by-case basis. Acceptance of promissory notes at this time for licence 2AM-JER1119 should in no way be interpreted as setting precedent for future decisions on security for this or any other permitting requirement.

Please contact Eva Paul or Andrew Keim in our Field Operations Division regarding the time required to amend the letters of credit and to provide the promissory note. All other correspondence related to security for licence 2AM-JER1119 should be directed to Manager Water Resources.

- ii. that this credit is due to expire in thirty (30) days or less and that the Applicant has not replaced this credit by posting with the Minister other security satisfactory to the Minister.

The water licence is referred to herein for reference purposes and does not form part of the terms of this credit.

We hereby agree that all drafts drawn under and in compliance with the terms of this credit shall be duly honoured by us if presented for payment on or before the operative expiration date.

This credit is subject to the Uniform Customs and Practice for Documentary Credits (2007 revision), International Chamber of Commerce, publication No. 600. Notwithstanding Article 36 of said publication, if this credit expires during an interruption of business as described in Article 36, we agree to effect payment if this credit is drawn on us within thirty (30) days after the resumption of business.
