Hello Lee,

Through discussion with INAC and the NWB and through a review of the current site water license it has been determined that your procedure for pumping out secondary containment is contemplated by condition Part F, Item #4(d). INAC is requesting that you pump out these structures, when necessary, to prevent overflow or berm structural damage, in accordance with the procedures you forwarded in your June 27, 2009 e-mail.

Please be advised that you must sample the discharge from the West Cell to stream C3 in accordance with your water license - specifically the discharge must meet the criteria listed in Part G, Item # 6 of the license which includes Oil and Grease. Should any criteria be exceeded the discharge to Stream C3 must stop.

INAC is further requesting that all sample analysis results be forwarded to this office as well as the Nunavut Water Board as soon as they are available - this includes the analysis from the contaminated water inside the on site secondary containment structures. This water should be analyzed for Total Extractable Hydrocarbons as per your procedure. The discharge water from the West Cell should also be analysed for Total Extractable Hydrocarbons as a precautionary measure. Should they be detected in the West Cell the discharge must cease.
