






Figure D.3-5 Kivalliq Tour Presentation









Figure D.3-6 Kivalliq Tour Presentation








Figure D.3-7 Kivalliq Tour Presentation








Figure D.3-8 Kivalliq Tour Presentation




Figure E.2-2 Baker Lake




Figure F.2-1 Baker Lake Elders






Figure F.2-2 Baker Lake Grade 12 Geology Class




Figure F.3 Chesterfield Inlet






Figure F.4 Coral Harbour




Figure F.6 Repulse Bay






Figure F.7 Whale Cove

# ADDITIONAL COMMENTS FROM OPEN HOUSES

### Arviat

- We lived in an area where there was a mining company long ago; we lived with the Scotties then. There is a photograph of the place we lived in a tent.
- We still use the wildlife and have to protect them, even today.
- We want more community events and funding.
- Can you make sure this HTO gets a copy of the report when it is done?

#### **Coral Harbour**

- We applaud the aboriginal representatives from Saskatchewan. I visited the sites in July
  and was impressed with the level of involvement. Not just jobs but there were people in
  higher jobs too. I came back and stressed training and I hope that we have the same
  level of involvement as Saskatchewan people. Organizational bodies now exist to help
  with monitoring.
- In 1944/45 I think the Inuit were impacted when there were bombs going off. We do not know where this impact happened but people had skin problems when I was a child after the war and we were thinking it was the bombs. So we have to make sure uranium is taken care of carefully.
- I prefer solid numbers rather than statements like 50% for all of Nunavut. Should not "finish-off" resources in one community before spreading out employment.
- AREVA would consider the hiring on an on-site Inuit elder similar to the program in Saskatchewan. Discussed the policy on respectful workplace and the reporting of incidents.
- I like to see other communities getting benefits even if they are not working. I know Kiggavik will run well so I am in support. I used to work in the DEW line. When you work with whites/southerners you work well with them. I think they will work well with Inuit like going to work on time.

# **Repulse Bay**

 Caribou migration may be disturbed. Meadowbank changed caribou migration to Repulse but do not think Kiggavik will change route because too far south.

## **Rankin Inlet**

- Inuit live off the land. Mining comes and mining goes.
- Monitoring effects is not good enough, we need to think about the future.



- When uranium is crushed it is far more radioactive because of the surface area so I am glad to see you have the tailings under water. I am still concerned about very fine particles and the downwind and downstream areas.
- Without mines we would all be stuck in our communities, there would be no infrastructure and little training.
- I want to know community consultant results from Susan Ross and Mitch Goodjohn.
- I do not want any mine at all, uranium or otherwise.
- My husband works in a good mine and now has cancer.

# **Chesterfield Inlet**

- I am concerned about the number of barge trips. Since increased barging we see less seals in the area and I am worried about marine life and spills. I want Chesterfield Inlet involved in any emergency spill response plan and I want it to be local and fast. I am not convinced that 23 will be the total number of barge trips and I expect it will keep increasing. I prefer a mix of flights and barges. I am not more or less concerned about yellowcake versus the other goods to be transported; rather, I am most concerned about the number of trips and potential spills.
- They set up the route to see if there are any belugas and I told them they would not see any. People should be consulted and work with your consultants. – commitment to have JW give results and plan meetings with Chesterfield HTO
- People from Baker Lake are against this Project, we hear it in the news.
- I hear that Agnico-Eagle is using elders as marine mammal observers but there is no reporting because the elders do not write. I think you should hire young people to work with the elders.
- Younger people do not feel like talking and asking questions in a public meeting when the elders are present. The elders want the youth to be more involved. I think you should have meetings or workshops focused on the younger generations.

#### **Whale Cove**

- Impressed by the powerful uranium pellet, a hunter joked about having a few for his ATV.
- Request to send an updated RLC list to each member.
