Janet Ikuutaq:

Concern about traditional grave sites, breathing contaminates, fishing sites, caribou calving grounds. Future birth defects & other deformed babies.

Contaminates on wildlife. Illnesses are going to become major problem even from drilling (diamond). I am opposed to the project proposal.

Environment, community is down-wind, down-stream-receiving end from the project proposed. Drilling & project proposal may have negative impact. Also to our caribou-they will disappear.

Jacob Ikinilik

Once I went on tour where old, previous diamond drill holes were cleaned & debris put in shed. I was told 'now they're safe & won't harm wildlife'. Later, at different site & date I saw drill hole exposed & oozing redish water. I asked 'is this harmful to wildlife?' 'No', came the answer.

When mining industry is determine to get what they want, they are not going to provide you with (honest answers) answers that are dangerous.

Phillippa Iksirag

The fish, birds, caribou, muskox, migration routes, & caribou calving grounds should be protected.

Thomas Oovavuk

I opposed to docking site, all-weather road at Hagli. I opposed to building of bridges over Thelon River. My reasons for opposing all-weather roads: This is our traditional hunting ground-summer & winter.

The whole environment surrounding Baker Lake is our fishing & caribou hunting ground.

Uranium mining, & all the revenues is not worth our cultural & traditional life-we have too much to lose

Caribou ARE like million dollars to Inuit, to Inuit, the caribou is worth million dollars

I am opposed to all-weather road anywhere across the community. Across the lake. Absolutely no roads should be built in our hunting areas. All is caribou traditional migration route. It would be more acceptable if bridge is built by near Halfway Hills.

If uranium mine is opening, strict rules & regulations has to be placed & enforced. My late husband helped to find the uranium deposits. Give me money. If diamond drilling is approved-it has to be acceptable to us (only way)

Winnie Ikinilik

Fish & caribou are my only diet of food. I opposed the project proposal.
