The Honourable Chuck Strahl has asked me to reply to your letter of February 24, 2009 regarding screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) of AREVA Resouces Canada Incorporated's *Kiggavik* mine development project proposal, Baker Lake Area, Kivalliq, NU (NIRB 09MN003, DIAND 5510-5-25). In your letter, you request additional time to screen the proposed project.

Under Article 12.4.5(b) of the *Nunavut Land Claims Agreement*, the period of time required for the screening of a project proposal by the NIRB may exceed 45 days with the approval of the Minister of Indian and Northern Affairs. I recognize that this project proposal involves unique considerations making screening within 45 days impossible for the NIRB. On the Minister's behalf, I am granting the NIRB permission to exercise this provision of the Land Claim and exceed the 45-day limit for the screening of this project. I would like to thank the NIRB for its diligence in the review of this proposal.

I note that the Nunavut Regional Office has advised you that the time period for the processing of this land use application has also been extended.
