Brief File History

- Minister of INAC highlighted key issues for NIRB:
 - The use of new technology for mine design, and operation and tailings containment.
 - The Minister stated : *"It is essential that these aspects of the Proposal are thoroughly assessed in order to ensure impact predictions to surface and ground water are accurate."*
 - The importance of a thorough cumulative effects assessment.
 - The Minister stressed that: *"Cumulative impacts of particular concern include those to caribou, caribou migration and calving grounds, and related socio-economic impacts to Baker Lake and other impacted communities."*

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Brief File History

- Minister of INAC highlighted key issues for NIRB (cont'd):
 - Scoping the proposal according to the Board's jurisdictional authority.
 - Ensuring the review is conducted in a manner which enables and supports meaningful participation of the public and facilitates thorough public consultation.
 - The Minister highlighted that: *"The very technical nature of some of the issues that have raised concern may warrant additional community information sessions."*

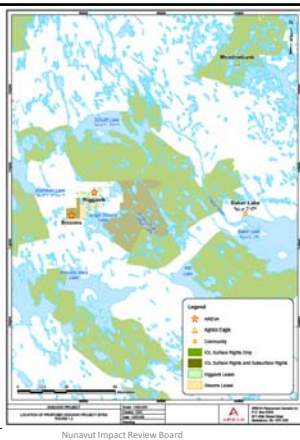

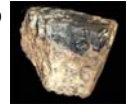

- Uranium is a radioactive element
- Found in soil, rock and surface and groundwater and ocean
- Largest deposits of uranium found in Australia, Kazakhstan and Canada

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Uranium Mining

- Similar to any other metal mining:
 - Uranium ore removed by open-pit mining or underground mining methods
 - Transportation of ore to mill for processing – ore is purified with addition of chemicals
 - Production of wastes and tailings
 - Shipment of uranium concentrate to refineries
- Wastes and tailings from mine contains radioactive elements
 - Requires special management
- Potential radiation doses to workers

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Uranium Regulation

- Uranium mining and milling industry is licensed, regulated and monitored by federal government – **Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission**
 - A federal quasi-judicial agency which reports to Parliament through the Minister of Natural Resources
 - Regulates the use of nuclear energy and materials
 - to protect the health, safety and security of Canadians and the environment;
 - to respect Canada's international commitments on the peaceful use of nuclear energy; and
 - to disseminate objective information on the CNSC.
