## Dear Parties:

On September 4, 2014 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) facilitated a community information session in Baker Lake to ensure that the community was aware of the pending submission of AREVA Resources Canada Inc.'s (AREVA) Final Environmental Impact Statement for the proposed "Kiggavik Uranium Mine" project (NIRB File No. 09MN003).

In addition, the NIRB held community information sessions in the Northern Saskatchewan communities of Wollaston Lake, Black Lake, and Fond du Lac from September 22-24, 2014. These sessions were held as a result of correspondence previously received by the NIRB on January 17, 2014 from the Athabasca Denesuline Negotiation Team which provided copy of a resolution and Motion 16 declaring the team's opposition to the transportation of uranium to Northern Saskatchewan, and raising concerns about consultation of the Dene land users
