#### SUMMARY OF RESEARCH:

The Kiggavik Sissons Project is a uranium surface exploration project located approximately 80 km west of Baker Lake. The project is made of two large groups of mining leases and mineral claims subdivided into Kiggavik to the north and Sissons to the south. The Kiggavik camp was first established in 1977 and it was occupied for drill programs until 1997. Exploration drilling has not taken place at the project since the end of the 1997 field season.
