Lupin Mines Incorporated (LMI or Company) is submitting this renewal/amendment Type A Water Licence Application and Final Closure and Reclamation Plan (FCRP) in accordance with the regulatory framework provided in the Nunavut Agreement and the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act* (NWNSRTA or Act) and *Nunavut Water Regulations* (Regulation) and well as the existing Type A Water Licence No. 2AM-LUP1520.

In lieu of separate letters from LMI, LMI herein confirms the following:

- A list of officers of the Company and list of external representatives (i.e., consultants) for purposes of this application are provided in the Application Form (Box 22); and
- A Statement of Financial responsibility is also provided in the Application Form (Box 23).

LMI would like to confirm their position with the NWB that the Company's financial responsibility is adequate for completion of the undertaking, mitigating adverse impact, ongoing maintenance, reclamation, and restoration of the undertaking. LMI is confident in assuming its position, taking into account its ongoing and past performance in the Kitikmeot Region, Nunavut, and Canada.

LMI intends to submit quarterly reports for review by the NWB, interested parties and Inspectors for confirmation of works completed. LMI expects the report will form the basis for the security refunds and will define the requests for security refund based on completion of line items provided in the most recent cost estimate, regardless of actual cost expended on the reclamation works. LMI believes refunds should be based on estimated values provided by LMI, given that the posting of security is based on an accepted estimate.

It is LMI's expectation that inspections to be completed by DIAND under the Act will be completed on a timely (i.e. quarterly) basis in line with LMI reporting such that the processes for securing of refunds can be applied efficiently, thereby allowing LMI to apply the refunds to ongoing reclamation works thus completing the work on schedule, as efficiently as possible.

Concordance has been provided in consideration of the Closure Terms and conditions of the current and prior Type A Water Licences issued for the Project (Refer to Appendix B of the FCRP). LMI anticipates that a review of the current Licence conditions will be carried out and those conditions

conditions related to the operations phase of the undertaking will be removed. LMI intends to provide a Draft Water Licence Framework during the regulatory review process for consideration.
