Subject: Licence No. 2AM-LUP1520 – Third-Party Report for the Review of

Reclamation Security, under Part C, Item 3 for the Lupin Mine

## Dear Parties:

As set out by the Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) in previous correspondence on September 8, 2016, in September the Board retained a neutral third-party consultant, Knight Piésold (KP) Ltd., to conduct a review of the reclamation security estimates filed with the Board by Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) and Lupin Mines Incorporated (LMI) for the Lupin Mine as part of the NWB's consideration of INAC's request to amend the amount of reclamation security held under Type "A" Water Licence 2AM-LUP1520 (the Licence). As discussed with the parties, following completion of a site visit attended by representatives from the NWB, KP, INAC and LMI, KP completed their review of the reclamation security estimates filed with the Board and has issued the attached report, summarizing the results of the third party review (the KP Report).

Parties interested in providing comments regarding the KP Report are requested to do so by <u>3 p.m.</u>, <u>MT on January 12, 2017</u>. When the comment period has closed, the Board plans to continue the process and timelines as outlined in Table 1 below. Parties are invited to note any questions or concerns regarding the proposed process and timelines with the Board when they file their comment submissions on the KP Report. Following the Board's receipt and review of all comments received, the NWB may issue any additional guidance or revisions to timelines or procedure, as may be requested or as the Board determines are necessary to complete a full and fair consideration of the amendment requested.
