Attached is my Inspection Report for the Reclamation Security of WL 2AM-LUP2032 for the Lupin Mine Site. I did the Site Inspection on October 10, 2021.

I apologize for the slight delay in getting this out as I have been having some Computer and Internet Issues for the last little while.

I acknowledge some updated information I have received from Dave Vokey since my Site Visit regarding Waste Oil and Site Closure. Specifically, the volume of Waste Oil burned in the Waste Oil Burner on Site during this season was 17,000 Litres. There is 8,000 Litres remaining to be burned from the second powerhouse waste oil tank next season. Also the Mine Site was Closed for the Season on October 20, 2021.

I would like to thank you and your Site Manager, Mr. Dave Vokey, for your co-operation and assistance during the Inspection Process.

I have cc'd the Nunavut Water Board in Gjoa Haven and my CIRNAC Headquarters in Iqaluit for their information and files.
