The 2009 Annual Report submitted by MMG. (Andrew Mitchell) addressed almost all of the requirements of the Water License # 2AM – LUP0914. However, it was noted that the following information was not provided in the 2009 Annual Report.

**Schedule B Item G** of the water license requires a summary of modification and/or major maintenance work carried out on the water supply and the waste disposal facilities, including all associated structures.

The report did state that only routine maintenance work was carried out at the site during 2009; however the Annual Report did not state what was involved in this routine maintenance work.

The proponent should provide a schedule of work, along with specific dates/timelines required to conduct routine work on-site for the upcoming year. All work should then be included in the annual report on March 31<sup>st</sup> of the following year.

These items were not included, but should be addressed in the 2009 Annual Report.

Lupin Mines Inc. should provide the Nunavut Water Board all outstanding information referred to above in order to comply with the requirements of Part B Item 2 of the water license.
