COMPLETION OF DISCHARGE FROM LUPIN TCF
WATER LICENSE NO. 2AM-LUP0914

Phyllis, this letter is to advise the Nunavut Water Board that the volume of water discharged from Pond 2 of the Lupin Tailings Containment Facility for the year 2009 will reach our objective of 3 million m³ on or about October 12th and accordingly we will discontinue discharge at that time. Monitoring of the water quality in Pond 2 at Monitoring Point LUP-10 will be discontinued at that time as well. Weekly monitoring of water quality at the Sun Bay monitoring points (LUP-20, 21, 24 and 25) will continue for a further two weeks time, as per the conditions of the water license.
