As previously discussed, Lupin Mines Incorporated is requesting to have our water licence (2AM-LUP1520) modified to remove the requirement of monitoring wells at the approved Landfarm.

Attached is a letter from Norwest Corporation (signed and stamped by the engineer) providing their professional opinion on monitoring wells for the Lupin Mine landfarm.

I have never seen one and I don't know how they perform in the North. If the engineer is confident in the technology, then I don't see why the board would not support your request. "
