Dear Spencer,

Enclosed is the most recent plan of the Lupin Tailings Containment Area, following the placement of sand cover in 2005. It shows the perimeter roads, perimeter dams, internal dams, lakes and polishing ponds, and the tailings cells. Note that the area designated Cell 4 is actually a primary polishing pond. The cells that were used to contain the tailings solids are Cell 1, Cell 2, Cell 3 and Cell 5. The small area to the northwest of Cell 5, labeled "N Dam" is an extension of Cell 5. Cells 1 and 2 have been completely covered, and Cells 3 and 5 partially covered, by a minimum 1-metre thickness of esker sand/gravel, which is shown as the stippled areas on the map. I have highlighted the remaining areas to be covered in yellow. All remaining cover will be placed this coming summer.
