Re: Lupin Mines Incorporated – Lupin Mine (Contwoyto Lake, NU) notice of MMER LC50 bioassay sampling schedule

In accordance with Nunavut Water Board Water Licence 2AM-LUP0914 (expired), Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada's 22 July 2015 Inspector's Direction and the Lupin Mines Incorporated (LMI) 2013 *Liquid Waste Management Plan* will undertake water quality monitoring and sublethal toxicity tests when discharge of effluent from the tailings containment area (TCA) commences on or after September 12, 2015.

LMI plans to discharge no more than 70,000 cubic meters per day of effluent, until freezing and/or weather prevents further discharge.

The effluent sampling procedures LMI plan for discharge are described in Appendix A Water Quality Monitoring Plan and Quality Assurance /Quality Control Plan of the Liquid Waste Management Plan. The Water Quality Monitoring Plan and Quality Assurance /Quality Control Plan is attached to this notification.
