Surveillance Network Program Monthly Report

As required by Part A, Item 6 of the Surveillance Network Program (Schedule 1) of Water License NWB1LUP0008, attached is the Lupin Mine Surveillance Network Program monthly report for **September 2005**.

The monthly and year-to-date water use volumes are included in the report for your review.

Discharge from SNP 925-14 to the environment was stopped on September 3, 2005. Total discharge at 925-14 during September was 6,314 cubic metres. Total discharge year-to-date was 263,508 cubic metres. A sample of the discharge had been taken 3 days earlier, for month-end August, and no plane was scheduled to arrive at Lupin for another 4 days. This would have rendered the sample unusable so no September sample was taken.

September 2005 sampling consisted of the annual fresh water sample at SNP Station 925-01.

No effluent was discharged during the month from 925-10.

Because of the low flow of water in the fresh water supply pipeline, the raw water totalizer has been giving inaccurate readings for the past few months. Total water use is now more accurately measured by the flow meters installed in the potable water line and the water to tails line. The water use figures for July and August have been revised to reflect these more accurate measurements, and are reflected in the year-to-date water use figures in the September report.
