Monthly Report for April 2009
Lupin Mine, Nunavut, License Number 2AM-LUP0914



Phyllis, a crew of between two and five persons were on site for 9 days from April 22 to April 30th, 2009. They were accommodated in a temporary tent camp erected in the lumber yard area of the site. Domestic water was drawn from Contwoyto Lake and trucked to the camp for dishwashing, laundry and showers. Grey water was discharged into the upper sewage lake. Solid and sanitary waste was removed from the site for disposal. The total water use is estimated to be 9 days x 200 L per person per day = 7,200 L or 7.2 m³.
