**Monthly Report for February 2009**  
**Lupin Mine, Nunavut, License Number 2AM-LUP0914**



Phyllis, a crew of four persons were on site for 5 days from May 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup>. They were accommodated in a temporary tent camp erected in the lumber yard area of the site. Domestic water was drawn from Contwoyto Lake and trucked to the camp for dishwashing and showers. Grey water was discharged into the lower sewage lake. Solid and sanitary waste was removed from the site for disposal. The total water use is estimated to be 5 days x 200 L per person per day = 4,000 L or 4.0 m<sup>3</sup>.
